Welcome to our Active Minds™ program - a new program which aims to enrich the learning journey of school-aged students from Pre-Primary through to Year 6. This is achieved through the delivery of foundational supports and tailored therapy, designed around the needs of each school. Our expert team of clinicians will work with schools to develop a tailored program to suit the unique needs of a school's student and teaching community.

What does the program offer?

- Developmental screenings for ADHD & behavioural disorders (individuals & class groups).
- Weekly therapeutic before and/or after school program delivered on-site by our expert team of Occupational Therapists, Speech Pathologists, and Exercise Physiologists. The program will be developed around evidence-based programs and strategies i.e. SOCS Speech Program; Zones of Regulation.
- Students granted priority access to our Occupational Therapy, Psychology, Exercise Physiology, Physiotherapy and Speech Pathology services (on-campus services are available).
- Regular teacher and parent workshops, hosted by Patches' medical & allied health team.
- Provision of Patches equipment pack, to encourage self-regulation and classroom movement breaks.
